### AGRONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

Fawn is a deep rooted variety of tall fescue excellent for forage, hay, and pasture usage. This variety has the ability to adapt to a wide variety of soil conditions and survive grazing. Fawn tolerates low fertility and can produce new growth in cool conditions. This will germinate quickly and produce strong seedling vigor. Fawn will tolerate drought conditions very well with its natural deep root system.

### SUGGESTED USAGE

Fawn is suitable for use in low maintenance areas or where erosion control is desired. Fawn will be an excellent choice for intensive grazing and animal traffic.

### TURF ESTABLISHMENT GUIDELINES

Adequate seed bed preparation is important in new turf grass establishment as well as in overseeding applications. Check soil pH and apply LESCO starter fertilizer prior to seeding. Cool-season grasses germinate best in the 60° to 85° F (16° to 30° C) soil temperature range. Frequent light irrigation and/or seed starter mulch is required for optimum germination. Germination should be visible within 14 days; complete turf establishment will take two to six months to exhibit mature growth characteristics.

### RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE PRACTICES

Highest quality and durability are reached using low to moderate maintenance levels. Deep and infrequent watering is encouraged for healthy longevity. Mowing practices are not always essential if using for animal grazing.

### ENVIRONMENTAL TOLERANCE

Fawn tall fescue is adapted throughout the Cool Humid, Cool Arid and Warm Humid zones.


