AGRONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

Estate Eagle Plus Mix is an excellent choice for premium turf when quick establishment and annual weed suppression is important. Estate Eagle Plus Mix will form a traffic tolerant turf with excellent recovery ability. The advanced turf grass varieties in this mix are resistant to gray leaf spot. The perennial ryegrass varieties contain endophytes for enhanced tolerance to surface feeding insects.

SUGGESTED USAGE

Estate Eagle Plus Mix is well suited for athletic fields, and premium commercial areas and home lawns. This mix is well suited for renovation of Kentucky bluegrass/perennial ryegrass areas with excellent rooting and recovery on compacted soils.

TURF ESTABLISHMENT GUIDELINES

Adequate seed bed preparation is important in new turf grass establishment as well as in overseeding applications. Check soil pH and apply LESCO starter fertilizer prior to seeding. Cool-season grasses germinate best in the 60° to 85° F (16° to 30° C) soil temperature range. Frequent light irrigation and/or seed starter mulch is required for optimum germination. Germination should be visible within 21 days; complete turf establishment will take six to eight months to exhibit mature growth characteristics.

RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE PRACTICES

Highest quality and durability are reached using moderate maintenance levels. Allow turf to establish prior to heavy use. Mowing height at 1/2" to 2 1/2" is recommended (lower mowing heights require higher maintenance).

ENVIRONMENTAL TOLERANCE

Estate Eagle Plus Mix is adapted to cool arid and cool humid zones.
