# WHITE WEDDING® HYDRANGEA

*Hydrangea X Paniculata*

ZONE 4-9



This plant has large, soft pillow white blooms held by sturdy upright branches. Blooms late spring throughout the summer. Use to brighten a partly shaded spot, mass together for a showy statement, or accent your cut flower garden. Can tolerate full sun.

#### LANDSCAPE USES:

Accent, container, mass, beds, hedge.

#### SIZE & GROWTH:

4-6' H x 3-5' W

#### CARE:

No pruning required; can dead head to promote new blooms. Fertilize in spring.

#### HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
