# SHAMROCK INKBERRY HOLLY

*Ilex Glabra 'Shamrock'*

ZONE 4-9



A compact, globe shaped evergreen shrub with glossy elongated leaves. Dark black berries showcased through winter. Very tolerant of many extremes including heat, water, cold, and acidity. Needs a male to produce fruit. Excellent boxwood replacement.

#### LANDSCAPE USES:

Foundation, hedge, mass, and rain garden.

#### SIZE & GROWTH:

5' H x 5' W

#### CARE:

Prune to shape. Fertilize yearly in spring.

#### HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
