# 'REAL GLORY' SHASTA DAISY

*Leucanthemum x Superbum*

ZONE 5-9



This double blooming Shasta daisy will brighten up any garden with the striking yellow centers and creamy white flowers. A profuse bloomer on strong stems from spring through fall. Deadhead spent flowers to encourage new blooms.

#### LANDSCAPE USES:

Perennial garden, cottage garden, small container, mixed container.

#### SIZE & GROWTH:

12-16" W x 24-36" H

#### CARE:

Medium water and fertilize once a month.

#### HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
