CERISE CHARM LOROPETALUM

Loropetalum Chinense 'Kurobijin'
ZONE 7-11



This loropetalum is truly a treasure with dark plum graceful foliage that does not fade. Small red tassel-like flowers in spring highlight this well behaved, compact evergreen shrub. Can tolerate light shade.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Foundation, container, mass, low hedge.

SIZE & GROWTH:

3-4' H x 3-4' W

CARE:

No pruning required. Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
