THUNDERSTRUCK™ RUMBLIN' RED™ CRAPE MYRTLE

Lagerstroemia x 'JM2'

ZONE 6-9



Masses of red flowers bloom against near-black, ruffled foliage in summer through fall. This crape myrtle matures lightning fast at 12 to 15 feet tall and 8 to 12 feet wide. Flashy blooms and foliage create a perfect storm in the landscape.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Ornamental.

SIZE & GROWTH:

12-15' H x 8-12' W

CARE:

Medium water and plant in well drained soil.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
