


FLAME THROWER® REDBUD

Cercis Canadensis 'NC2016-2'

ZONE 5-9



A unique color breakthrough in redbuds. The new foliage emerges deep red and ages to bright yellow and green. A perfect small tree for a landscape needing a specimen or mass planting for both flower and foliage interest.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Specimen, mass.

SIZE & GROWTH:

20' H x 15' W

CARE:

Prune to shape. Fertilize yearly in spring.

HOW TO PLANT:

- 1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole 2 times the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
- 2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
- 3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
- 4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
- 5. Water in well.
- 6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
