

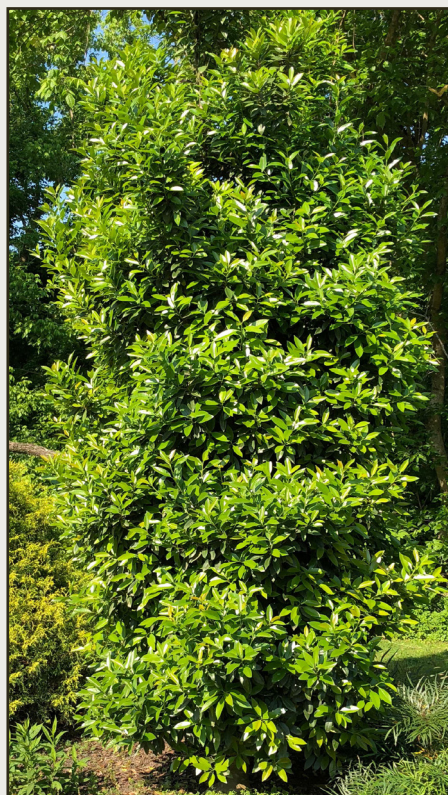

SCREEN PLAY HOLLY

Ilex Integra × Latifolia 'Screen Play'

ZONE 7-9



This new evergreen holly hybrid has many of the best features from this large genus of plants. With a dense, well branched upright habit, glossy spineless leaves that are light green with a bronze tint. Dark red berries in early winter. Great for compact areas to screen off unwanted views. Can tolerate part shade.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Hedge, screen, accent, privacy, and mass.

SIZE & GROWTH:

30' H x 10' W

CARE:

Medium water and plant in well drained soil.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
