

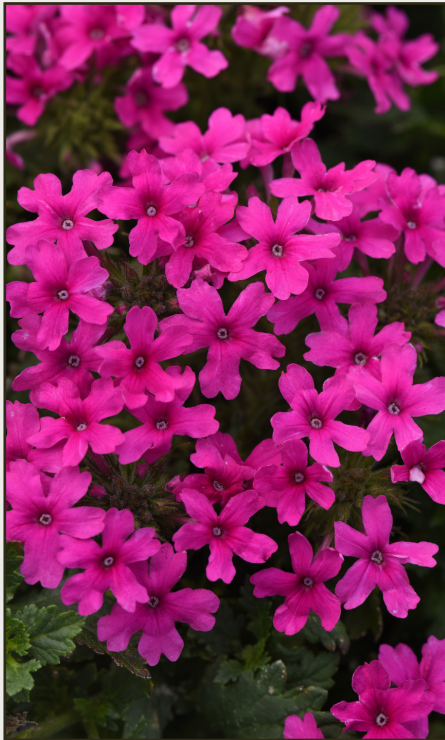

'HOMESTEAD HOT PINK' VERBENA

Verbena Canadensis

ZONE 6-9



Produces a carpet of hot pink flowers like its namesake 'Homestead Purple' and works as a wonderful groundcover. Mildew and deer resistant.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Butterfly garden, ground cover, border, rock garden, hanging basket, cottage garden, mixed container, landscape.

SIZE & GROWTH:

18-24" W x 4-6" H

CARE:

Prefers well-drained soils in a sunny location. Fertilize monthly during the growing season to promote season-long flowering.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
