



And the winner is...

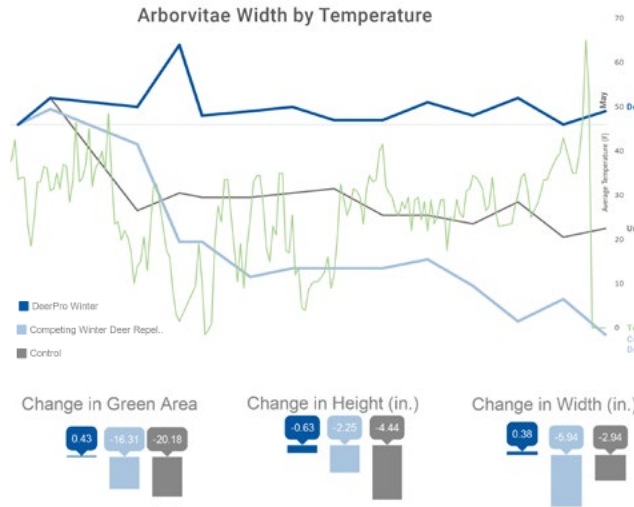
After 28 weeks, the results were finally in.

Arborvitae treated with **DEERPRO WINTER** lost significantly less green area compared to a competing winter deer repellent.

Deer tracks and trail camera footage revealed deer browsing the shrubs soon after they were planted. However, **DEERPRO WINTER** stood out as the most effective.

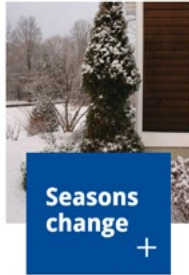

Twelve arborvitae shrubs were split between three treatment types; DeerPro Winter, another leading winter repellent and untreated control. The shrubs were monitored bi-weekly from October through May.
