Angelonia 'Ruby Sangria'

ZONE 10-11



This Angelonia is a striking variety with its upright and compact habit forms neat mounds. The flowers are a stunning ruby-red contrasting against the dark green foliage. This variety is tolerant of heat, humidity, and droughts. It is an excellent choice for adding charm to beds and containers.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Bed, Border, Container, Annual Color

SIZE & GROWTH:

12-14" H X 10-12" W

CARE:

Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
