FROSTBITE BUGLOSS

Brunnera Macrophylla 'Frostbite'

ZONE 4a-9a



Frostbite offers the perfect balance of silver-to-green foliage for shade gardens. It is a great late-season performer, holding its striking pattern with minimal browning. In spring, bright blue flowers are an extra bonus. Deer and rabbit resistant, it is ideal for beds and borders.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Bed, Border

SIZE & GROWTH:

6-9" H x 13-16" W

CARE:

Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
