'RUBY RED' RED YUCCA

Hesperaloe Parviflora 'Ruby Red'

ZONE 5-11



Ruby Red is a red yucca with a distinctive growth habit, forming low clumps of slender, arching leaves. Its unique feature is its striking, deep red flowers that stand out against the green foliage. It is highly adaptable and thrives in a range of challenging conditions, demonstrating remarkable hardiness in drought-prone areas.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Bed, Border, Container, Mass Planting

SIZE & GROWTH:

3-4' H X 3-4' W

CARE:

Prefers infrequent watering after establishment.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
