# SILVER SWIRL DUSTY MILLER

*Centaurea 'Balcentsirl'*

**ZONE 6b-9b**



Silver Swirl has silvery-white foliage with wavy leaf edges that make it stand out in the landscape. It is perfect for combos and front-of-the-border plantings. It offers better winter hardiness than other *Centaurea* options. This low-maintenance plant is a great way to add texture and attract the eye!

#### LANDSCAPE USES:

Bed, Border, Container

#### SIZE & GROWTH:

8-11" H x 11-14" W

#### CARE:

Regular water until established.

#### HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
