Veronica Hybrida 'Novaverblu'

ZONE 4-9



Compact series of first year flowering Veronica. Continuous blooms until first frost. Attracts pollinators, is heat and drought tolerant.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Perennial garden, cottage garden, small container, formal garden, mixed container.

SIZE & GROWTH:

12-14" W x 12-14" H

CARE:

Prefers well-drained soil in full sun, although will tolerate a wide range of soils and conditions.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
