Orange Marmalade adds a tropical flare to borders and containers with its vibrant, orange flowers and glossy, green leaves. It withstands the heat of the Summer and Fall, thriving in full to partial sun.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Border, Container, Houseplant

SIZE & GROWTH:

12-24" H X 12-24" W

CARE:

Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.

- Mounded, shiny, deep green leaves that retain their color throughout the year
- Boasts excellent disease and pest resistance
- Heat tolerant
