PAINTED SKY™ HYDRANGEA

Hydrangea Macrophylla 'GRENAN'
ZONE 4-9



This prolific repeat blooming hydrangea packs a punch of colors reminiscent of the sky it was named for. Flowers from summer until frost, with colors ranging from blue to pink depending on soil acidity. A vigorous grower, with rounded compact habit. Perfect for any partially shaded garden. Flowers are blue in acidic soil and pink in alkaline soil.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Accent, border, mass, beds, hedge, and containers.

SIZE & GROWTH:

4-6' H x 4-6' W

CARE:

Prune after flowering to maintain shape and promote re-bloom. Water until established then as needed.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
