ROYAL HAWAIIAN® WAIKIKI ELEPHANT EAR

Colocasia Esculenta 'Waikiki'

ZONE 7-11



This Elephant Ear features glossy, deep green foliage with white markings and bright pink veins. In rich, wet soils, this will spread freely. It is an ideal option for borders, containers, water gardens, and at poolside.

LANDSCAPE USES

Border, Container, Mass, Poolside, Specimen, Water Garden.

SIZE & GROWTH:

30-36" H x 30-36" W

CARE:

Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
