'SILVER ANOUK' LAVENDER

Lavandula Stoechas

ZONE 6-9



Dark violet flower spikes topped by clear purple flags. This Spanish Lavender has frosty silver foliage with great disease resistance. Outstanding in containers and landscapes.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Perennial garden, border, vegetable/herb garden, large container, mixed container.

SIZE & GROWTH:

12-14" W x 14-18" H

CARE:

Full sun and well-drained soil. Prune back to 6 in. (15 cm) in the Spring.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
