STRAIGHT A® BARLEY BLUE AFRICAN LILY

Agapanthus Praecox 'Barley Blue'

ZONE 8-11



Straight A® Barley Blue is an early blooming Agapanthus that features light blue flowers and strong stems. It has a compact habit, making it perfect for borders and containers. It prefers full sun to part shade and is drought tolerant.

LANDSCAPE USES:

Border, Container, Landscape, Mass

SIZE & GROWTH:

18-24" H x 18-24" W

CARE:

Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant.
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.

- Early bloomer, featuring light blue flowers
- Compact habit and strong stems
- Attracts pollinators
- Deer resistant and humidity tolerant
