WHAT A DOOZIE STONECROP

Sedum Spurium 'Spiraling Doozie'

ZONE 5a-9b



This spreading Sedum stands out with its white and green variegated foliage, providing season-long interest. In fall, plants turn blush pink and creamy pink flowers appear. It provides a drought-tolerant option for containers or groundcover in the garden.

LANDSCAPE USES

Container, Groundcover.

SIZE & GROWTH:

2-5" H x 11-14" W

CARE:

Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
