Target Crop: Turfgrass

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN Application Rate: 1 gallon per acre

Application Instructions:

- 1. B.O.M.B. should be mixed thoroughly prior to application. Shake the container or stir the contents.
- 2. B.O.M.B. can be applied through an irrigation injection system and can be applied alone or mixed with fertilizers. (A jar test should always be performed prior to full application.)
- 3. B.O.M.B. can be watered in by regular irrigation or rain fall.
- 4. Application should be made when soil temperatures are between 60-100° F.
- 5. Core aerification or spiking prior to an application of B.O.M.B. is helpful to ensure better contact with organic matter.
- 6. Allow 2-3 days between applications of B.O.M.B. and the use of herbicides, fungicides, and insecticides.
