ROCK CANDY® RUBY BEARD TONGUE

Penstemon Barbatus 'Novapenrub'

ZONE 5a-8b



A Beard Tongue that features spikes of bell-shaped, deep pink flowers atop mounded, green foliage. It blooms heavily in late spring and will rebloom in late summer if lightly trimmed after first flush. It makes a great addition to borders and containers.

LANDSCAPE USES

Border, Container, Firescape, Mass.

SIZE & GROWTH:

12-18" H x 12-18" W

CARE:

Lightly prune spent flowers to encourage repeat bloom in late summer. Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
