Dianthus X Barbatus Interspecific 'PAS1350217'

ZONE 5a-8b



An upright Dianthus that blooms from late spring well into fall. It's blooms open white and mature to light pink, then deep pink. The lacy, fragrant blooms attract pollinators. It is an excellent option for perennial borders and mass plantings.

LANDSCAPE USES

Border, Mass.

SIZE & GROWTH:

18-24" H x 10-12" W

CARE:

During growing season, lightly fertilize monthly to keep them growing and producing. Deadhead early season blooms to encourage new buds to form. Regular water until established.

HOW TO PLANT:

1. Set your plant and align in your space properly. Dig a hole twice the width of the root ball and a depth to leave 1-2 inches above grade.
2. Add any planting amendments and prepare the soil. Remove any packaging and tags from the plant.
3. Gently scar and loosen the roots and place in the hole.
4. Bring soil up to and cover the root ball of the plant
5. Water in well.
6. Finish with mulch and water regularly until established.
